

Wewelsburg

- .Placed in Büren
- .Founded in 1609
- .Above the Almetal on a mountain spur
- .Today there are exhibitions
- .In the south and east wing is placed the regional history department of the local museum
- .It is a former SS Peel Castle with an exhibition about the history of the SS
- .Memorial of the terror from the SS



Soest

- .In the Middle Ages Soest was an important Hanseatic city
- .Typical is the green sandstone
- .Beautiful half-timbered houses and romantic alleys leave their mark on the city center
- .A part of the old wall is preserved and brilliant for walks
- .Soest is especially known for their fair each autumn
- .The Möhne a 65,1 km² long tributary near Soest



Forum der Völker

- Placed in the city Werl
- The biggest ethnological museum in Westfalen
- Because of the collection it is one of the significant ethnology museums of Germany
- 11.000 items
- Opened 1962 and several times expanded



Salinen in Badwesternkotten

- Placed in the health resort Bad Westernkotten
- 2 graduation works- salt collector
- Historic-cultural and technical architectural monument
- In former time used for salt production
- Today for therapeutic inhalation



Salzwelten in Bad Sassendorf

- .Placed in Bad Sassendorf
- .An interactive museum about the history of salt
- .It has a regional salt route and an Adventure Exhibit
- .Opened in spring 2015
- .There are a caverns full of crystal, an exhibition about salt, salt water and moor, a salt collector and a fictitious bath world for relaxation
- .You can discover natural remedy and explore how a salt farmhand had worked
- .You can follow the salt trace to the scene of the salt production
